

## **Weed Resistance Management**

We have only affected weeds too little for too long. As the saying goes a dead weed is a dead weed. If it is not dead then to spray it the second or third time in one growing season only makes you feel better. You tried.

The trend in the crop protection industry is to spray weeds at a very small size. Weeds at any stage of crop growth can reduce yield and make problems for years to come.

Higher tolerance to glyphosate helps weeds survive even better and makes them harder to kill. You have a greater choice in herbicides for weeds in corn than in soybeans. Use multiple herbicide modes of action with overlapping weed spectrum in rotation or mixtures. Use the full recommended herbicide rate and proper application timing for the hardest to control weed species in your fields.
